



INFANT SUPPLY LIST

(Ages 6 weeks - 12 months and walking)

Please write your child's first and last name on each item

These need to be brought to Meet the Teacher OR the First Day of School

- 3 - Pacifiers** - To keep at school. **Labeled individually with your child's name.**
- 2 - Boxes of Kleenex** - *square* box (not rectangular)
- 2 - Containers of Clorox Wipes**
- 2 - Flip Top Diaper Wipe Packages** - **This must be labeled with your child's name.** Will ask for more as needed.
- 3 - Extra Sets of Clothing** - **Clearly labeled with your child's name, in a sealed bag** - In case of accidents. Please include socks.
- 1 - Package of Diapers** - **This must be labeled with your child's name.** The teachers will tell you when more diapers are needed.
- 1 - Diaper Rash Cream** - **Labeled with your child's name.**

Bottles *Daily* Breastmilk - **Send enough bottles for their daily feedings.** The bottles **MUST** be labeled with your child's first and last name, date, and with the time milk was expressed.

Bottles *Daily* Formula - Send enough bottles for their daily feedings. The bottles **MUST** be labeled with your child's first and last name.

Container of formula (unopened) - **Labeled with your child's name.**

***Daily* baby food** (when age appropriate) - **Labeled with your child's first and last name.**

- 1 - Bottle or Spill Proof Sippy Cup** (when age appropriate) for water ***to keep at school*** - **Labeled with your child's name.**
- 2 - *Daily* Burp Clothes** - **Labeled with your child's name.** These will be sent home daily to be laundered.
- 2 - Sleep sacks** - May not be swaddle or padded. (**Labeled with your child's name**). One will be sent home every Friday to be laundered (or sooner if soiled).
- 4 - Bibs** - Fabric Bibs (plastic back preferred). **Labeled with your child's name.** These will be sent home as needed for laundering.
- 1 - Diaper Bag** - Labeled with your child's name.
- 1 - Small bag for dirty laundry** - **Labeled with your child's name** This will be sent home daily with your child's dirty items.
